Call For Papers

About the conference

The Department of Management Studies and Industrial Engineering (DMS&IE), IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, is organizing a two-day doctoral colloquium on Financial Markets & Corporate Finance (DCFMCF) on 17-18 February 2025. The colloquium is open for doctoral students only, and only full papers are allowed to be submitted. The colloquium provides researchers the opportunity to share their ideas in detail in front of experts in the field. Also, each accepted paper will be allotted an expert discussant from the field who will review the paper and discuss the comment in detail, which will provide researchers with the opportunity to improve the quality of the paper to submit to reputed journals.

Doctoral students can submit their paper in the broader area of financial markets, corporate finance and accounting

Eligibility

- The colloquium is open to doctoral students only.
- Only one paper per doctoral student is permitted.
- The paper should be unpublished and original.
- Empirical papers will be preferred.

Basic Submission Guidelines:

- Only full papers are allowed to be submitted (no extended abstract) in pdf/word along with at least 4 keywords.
- Papers shall not be longer than 10,000 words, including bibliography and references, formatted in Times New Roman, 12-point font, with double line spacing and a 1" margin on all sides.
- Submission also required a cover letter separate from the manuscript, which should include authors' names, affiliations, contact details, and the current stage in the research journey.
- Upon acceptance of the paper, authors will be asked to submit a nomination letter from the thesis supervisor on department letterhead, which should contain the signature and affiliation details of the supervisor, along with the official seal.
- Accepted papers will be allotted a discussant who will review the paper and will discuss the comments after the presentation.
- Submitted papers must be free from any plagiarized content. If plagiarism is detected, the paper will not proceed to the review process. All papers will be blind reviewed to ensure adequate standards and quality outcomes.

Registration Fees

There is no registration fee for the presenter. The organizer will cover the accommodation and fooding charges for the presenters on the event days.
