IIT (ISM) Dhanbad marked its 100th Foundation Day, celebrating a century of contributions to engineering education, earth sciences, energy research and national development. The Foundation Day ceremony, held at the Penman Auditorium, marked the culmination of the Centenary Foundation Week (3–9 December 2025), inaugurated by Dr. P. K. Mishra, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister. The week-long celebrations comprised academic and thematic symposia, exhibitions, cultural programmes, alumni interactions and community outreach activities, collectively highlighting the institute's rich historical legacy and its future-oriented vision.



The event was graced by Shri Gautam Adani, Chairman of the Adani Group, as Chief Guest. The facility enables students to visualize critical aspects of bord and pillar mining, including roadway development, pillar formation, roof support systems, ventilation planning, and safety measures, thereby bridging the gap between theoretical instruction and real-world mining practices.

Professional Development Program on Latest Tunneling Techniques for NHPC Executives at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad

The Department of Mining Engineering, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, successfully conducted a three-day Professional Development Program (PDP) on "Introduction to the Latest Tunneling Techniques" for executives of NHPC Limited from 22–24 December 2025. The programme aimed to bridge the gap between academic advancements and industry practices by familiarising participants with state-of-the-art tunneling methods and emerging technologies relevant to large-scale infrastructure and hydropower projects.



The technical sessions covered a wide spectrum of topics, including modern tunnel excavation techniques, mechanised and conventional tunneling systems, rock mass characterization, ground control measures, numerical modelling, monitoring and instrumentation, and safety and risk management in underground construction. Special emphasis was placed on recent innovations such as Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs), New Austrian Tunnelling Method (NATM), and the integration of digital tools for design and performance assessment.

Mine Survey Camp 2025: Practical Training in Modern Mine Surveying



The Mine Survey Camp 2025, conducted from 01 – 07 December 2025, was an integral part of the M.Tech. (Geomatics) curriculum of the Department of Mining Engineering, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, aimed at providing hands-on exposure to contemporary mine surveying practices. The programme was organized under the leadership of Prof. Dheeraj Kumar and Prof. V. G. K. Villuri, with academic and technical support from Dr. Sunil Kumar, Mr. Dayamoy Karmakar, and Mr. Sudhanshu Pandey.

A total of 15 M.Tech. (Geomatics) students participated in the camp and carried out a detailed survey of the IIT (ISM) Dhanbad campus using advanced surveying instruments. The field training enabled students to gain practical experience in modern measurement techniques, data acquisition, and professional field procedures, while enhancing their technical competence, teamwork, and confidence.

The successful conduct of the camp reflects the department's continued commitment to integrating theoretical learning with practical application in the field of mine surveying and geomatics.

Industrial Mine Excursion for B.Tech. Students: Exposure to Contemporary Mining Practices

The Department of Mining Engineering organized an Industrial Mine Excursion for B.Tech. Fourth Semester students on 26–27 December 2025 to provide practical exposure to large-scale mining and mineral processing operations. The visit covered the Noamundi Iron Ore Mines of Tata Steel and the Narwapahar Mine and Mill of Jaduguda Uranium Limited.



A total of 87 students participated in the excursion. At Noamundi, students observed modern opencast mining practices, including drilling and blasting, heavy earth-moving machinery operations, and systematic ore handling, gaining insights into scientific mine planning, safety management, and sustainable mining practices. The visit to Narwapahar offered exposure to underground uranium mining, ore beneficiation processes, radiation safety protocols, and environmental protection measures.



The excursion enabled students to effectively link theoretical concepts with field practices through interactions with industry professionals, thereby enhancing their technical awareness and professional outlook. The initiative reflects the department's continued commitment to experiential learning and industry-oriented education.



Bord & Pillar Training Gallery Visit

The Bord & Pillar Training Gallery was visited by distinguished guests including Shri M. Vellaipandi, Director General, STQC, MeitY, on 20 December 2025, and Shri U. K. Such experiential learning initiatives enhance the students' comprehension of theoretical concepts, strengthen their practical skills, and prepare them for professional challenges in underground mining environments.



The training gallery offered a controlled environment where students could connect classroom theory with real-world mining practices, enhancing their understanding of operational challenges, risk mitigation strategies, and equipment utilization in underground coal mining. Interactive sessions with instructors and technical staff allowed students to clarify concepts, discuss best practices, and gain insights into technological innovations employed in contemporary mining operations.

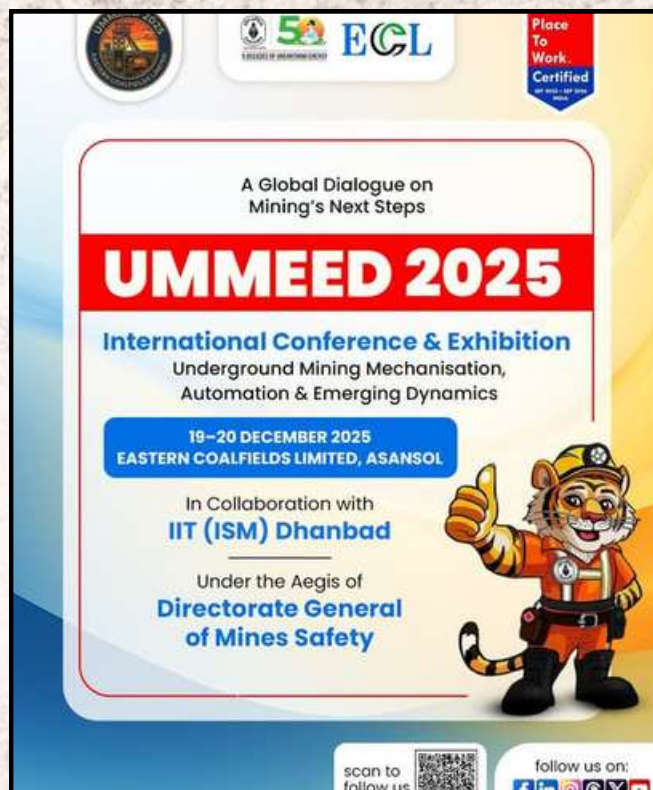


UMMEED 2025: International Conference and Exhibition on Underground Mining Mechanization and Automation
