Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines), Dhanbad [IIT (ISM) Dhanbad] has been entrusted for the establishment of a mining technology innovation hub under the National Mission for Interdisciplinary Cyber-Physical Systems (NMICPS). As mandated under the framework of National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber-Physical Systems (NM-ICPS) by the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Govt. of India, Technology Innovation Hub (TIH) at IIT (ISM) is aimed at becoming the nodal centre heading the innovation activities in Exploration and Mining.

In order to carry out the activities of TIH, a Section 8 SPV has been established in the name of TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION IN EXPLORATION AND MINING FOUNDATION (TEXMiN) at IIT (ISM). 1.	(a) The TEXMiN reserves its right to place a reasonable limit on the total number of candidates to be called for the selection process. (b) Fulfilment of qualifications per-se does not entitle a candidate to be called for the selection process. Desirable qualifications shall also be taken into account for the scrutiny of applications. (c) The TEXMiN reserves the right for an exceptionally meritorious candidate, the selection/scrutiny committee may relax the essential experience. (d) The TEXMiN reserves the right not to fill up the positions, cancel the Advt. inwhole or in part without assigning any reason, and its decision in this regard shall be final.
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	(e) All advertised positions are purely temporary and contractual in nature, and the selected candidates cannot claim for appointment against any regular positions in the Institute/ TEXMiN. (f) The engagement of all advertised positions will be subject to their medical fitness and Police Verification. (g) The TEXMiN reserves its right to terminate the contractual engagement of all advertised positions by giving one month notice or one month's remuneration in lieu thereof without assigning any reason. (h) Leave is not a matter of right. However, all advertised positions may be allowed 30 days' Casual Leave in a calendar year. 4.	The shortlisted candidates will be called for an Interview. In the event of receipt of a large number of applications, a written test may also be conducted for shortlisting the candidates for interview. The final selection will be on the basis of performance in the interview. The Committee constituted to conduct the Practical Trade Test and Written Test will decide the minimum qualifying marks for the Written & Practical Trade Test in accordance with the number of vacancies and performance of the candidates, and its decision shall be final.
