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1.0 ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines) Dhanbad was established in 1926, and offers B. Tech., Dual-degree (B. Tech. and M.Tech), Integrated M.Tech, M.Sc./M.Sc. Tech., M.Tech, MBA and Ph.D. in various areas of Science: Applied Geology | Applied Geophysics | Chemistry | Mathematics & Computing | Physics | and Engineering: | Chemical | Civil | Computer Science and Engineering | Electrical | Electronics | Environmental Science and Engineering | Fuel, Minerals & Metallurgical Engineering | Mechanical | Mining | Mining Machinery | Petroleum | Humanities | and Management. IIT (ISM) has centenary long credentials of outperforming achievements/contributions in academia and the industry. It has been focusing its academic and research activities on various aspects of science, technology and industry, occupying a unique position not only in India, but also abroad. It has substantially contributed to the development of the Science, Engineering and Mineral sector through its in-house state-of-the-art facilities for advanced studies and research.

1.1 Location of the Institute

IIT(ISM) is located in the city of Dhanbad, the coal capital of India, which is at the heart of major Indian coalfields, in the state of Jharkhand. One can reach Dhanbad by rail and road. It is 260 KM from Kolkata and 160 KM from Ranchi. Nearby airports are in Kolkata, Durgapur and Ranchi. Deluxe and Express buses run regularly from Kolkata, Ranchi, Jamshedpur and Bokaro to Dhanbad. IIT(ISM) campus is just 3 km away from Dhanbad railway station where taxis and autos operate round the clock.

2.0 ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The four-year integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed. programme at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad is a full-time residential program that aims to develop future teachers who will lead, inspire, and actively adapt to evolving educational landscape, so as to make positive impact on the process of creation of future leaders, managers and entrepreneurs in their respective domains.

The programme emphasizes a dual-major approach with the opportunity to pursue B.Sc. with major in one of the disciplines, namely Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics along with Major in B.Ed. with secondary stage specialization.

As a student, you will get the rare chance to study Physics, Chemistry, or Mathematics –based on your chosen field – under the guidance of faculty members of Indian Institute of Technology (IIT). This is a level of academic mentorship that most B.Sc. students across the country can only aspire to have. And that's just the beginning. 2.0 Admission for Academic Year 2026-27

The provisional Admission offer will be made to the applicants who fulfil the eligibility criteria as prescribed by IIT (ISM) Dhanbad as per the details submitted by them in the online application form available at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad's admission portal, considering the performance of candidates in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). The final admission of the provisionally selected candidates will depend upon physical verification of original documents in support of fulfilment of their eligibility as well as selection criteria at the time of reporting at IIT (ISM), Dhanbad for final admission.

3.2 Eligibility Criteria for Academic Year 2026-27

The following eligibility criteria must be fulfilled by the respective candidates in order to apply for admission to the 4 year integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed. program at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad.

- Candidates must have passed the 10+2 examination (or equivalent qualifying examination).
- In 10+2 examination (or equivalent qualifying examination), candidates must have secured minimum
 - 60% marks (for UR and EWS category candidates)
 - 55% marks (for OBC-NCL category candidates)
 - 50% marks (for SC/ST/PwD category candidates)
- Candidates should have been born on or after-
 - 01 August 2006 (for UR and EWS category candidates)
 - 01 August 2003 (for OBC-NCL category candidates)
 - 01 August 2001 (for SC/ST/PwD category candidates)
- For admission in B.Sc. (Physics)- B.Ed. –
 - Candidates must have written the NCET 2026 in Physics as one of their domain subjects.
 - Candidates must have studied Physics and Mathematics in their 10+2
- For admission in B.Sc. (Chemistry)- B.Ed. –
 - Candidates must have written the NCET 2026 in Chemistry as one their domain subjects
 - Candidates must have studied Chemistry and Mathematics in their 10+2

6. For admission in B.Sc. (Mathematics)- B.Ed. –

(i) Candidates must have written the NCET 2026 in Mathematics/Applied Mathematics as one of their domain subjects

(ii) Candidates must have studied Physics and Mathematics in their 10+2

4.0 Fees for Academic Year 2026-27

4.1 Application Fee

Candidates seeking admission will have to pay a non-refundable application fee of Rs.1200/- for Male (Gen/OBC/EWS) and Rs. 600/- for Female/SC/ST/PwD.

5.0 Reservation of seats

- Reservation for SC/ST (Certificate Format –Annexure III) /OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/PwD/EWS candidates will be as per Government of India rules.
- Valid OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (given in Annexure I) must be produced by OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates in the format for ‘Admission to Central Educational Institutions (CEIS) under the Government of India’ and **should be issued on or after April 01, 2026.**
- Valid EWS category certificate (given in Annexure II) must be produced by a candidate in the format for ‘Admission to Central Educational Institutions (CEIS) under the Government of India’ and **should be issued on or after April 01, 2026.**

6.0 Medical Fitness

- Candidates must be in good health. A candidate is required to submit a medical certificate (as per Annexure IV) at the time of reporting at IIT(ISM) Dhanbad signed by the Authorised medical officer or equivalent of a government hospital.
- A candidate will be allowed to take admission only if the certificate produced by the candidate is verified to be satisfactory by IIT(ISM) officials, whose decision in this regard will be final.

7.0 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Online application form is required to be submitted through IIT(ISM) Dhanbad’s online portal, www.iitism.ac.in from **June 1-19, 2026**. After submitting the form, the candidates are advised **to download the application confirmation page** and keep the same for record.
- Candidates can apply for more than one discipline and select up to 3 preferences, if eligible.
- Candidates seeking admission will have to pay a **non-refundable** application fee of Rs.1200/- for Male (Gen/OBC/EWS) and Rs. 600/- for Female/SC/ST/PwD. The application fee needs to be paid through online payment gateway only along with the online application.

- (d) It is the **responsibility of the candidate** to ensure that he/she satisfies all eligibility criteria for a particular program, as mentioned in this information brochure, and submit complete and correct information in the Institute admission portal accordingly.
- (e) Clear Image quality of the uploaded documents must be good enough to enable easy verification of the documents/items. Care should be taken to scan the documents (with file format jpg/jpeg) with the help of a high quality scanner. The candidate should check the quality of the soft document before uploading.
- (f) The following documents are required to be uploaded during the document uploading.
- (i) Image files of your recent passport size photograph and signature.
 - (ii) Qualifying Examination (Intermediate mark sheet 10+2) as per eligibility.
 - (iii) NCET 2026 score card as indicated in the application form.
 - (iv) Caste certificate to avail seat reservation under respective reserved category. OBC-NCL, EWS certificate as per Annexure I, II, respectively and issued on or after **April 01, 2026**).
 - (v) Persons with Disability (PwD) are required to upload UDID/ a certificate of disability from the **authorized medical board** attached to one of the following - Vocational Rehabilitation Centre (VRC) for Physically Handicapped persons/ Special Employment Exchange for Physically Handicapped/ Government Hospital (District and State level).
- (g) The candidate will have to report in-person at IIT(ISM), Dhanbad on the scheduled date, time and venue for completing the admission. If the candidate fails to report at the admission venue in-person along with the requisite documents in original by that date and time, he/she will not be considered afterwards for admission. The date for reporting at the Institute for physical verification of documents will be notified later.
- (h) In addition to original copy of above mentioned documents following original documents must be produced by the candidate at the time of **reporting** to IIT (ISM) Dhanbad to complete the admission:
- (i) Copy of the online application form.
 - (ii) Copy of NCET 2026 Score Card in support claimed score.
 - (iii) Copy of the seat allotment letter.
 - (iv) Copy of Admission fee payment receipt.
 - (v) The Migration Certificate or School/ College Leaving Certificate.
 - (vi) Photo ID (Aadhar/PAN/DL etc) and Proof of age (Date of Birth Certificate /Matriculation certificate, etc.)
 - (vii) **OBC Non-Creamy Layer certificate** issued on or after **1st April 2026** (refer Annexure I).
 - (viii) **SC/ST Certificate** (refer Annexure III).
 - (ix) **EWS certificate** issued on or after **1st April 2026** (refer Annexure II).
 - (x) **Persons with Disability (PwD)** are required to produce valid UDID card in and PwD certificate in applicable format.
 - (xi) All the relevant educational qualification certificates, including the qualifying examination, recently issued migration certificate etc.
 - (xii) **A Medical fitness certificate** as per Annexure IV
 - (xiii) 4 passport size recent colour photographs
- (i) It is important to note that the admission will be provisional even after completing all other procedures & formalities until the submission of proof of fulfilment of **Eligibility criteria mentioned at 3.2** of this Information Brochure on the date given by the Institute for physical reporting.
- Failure to submit the requisite document by the stipulated date (latest by September 30, 2026) will lead to cancellation of admission and names of all such candidates will be deleted from the rolls of the Institute w.e.f. October 01, 2026 without further notice. In such cases the candidates will be refunded only caution money deposited at the time of admission.
- (j) The documents of the candidates will be verified by IIT(ISM) officials. Admission of only those candidates, whose documents are found in order and verified as satisfactory, will be confirmed.
- (k) Hostel mess fee for the first semester have to be paid at the time of admission. Caution money and security deposits are refundable only after completion of the program.

8.0 Withdrawal of Admission

Candidate may withdraw his/her provisional admission before physical reporting at IIT(ISM), Dhanbad and withdrawal request may be sent to AR (Admissions) at aradm@iitism.ac.in by e-mail from the registered email ID of the candidate. Refund on withdrawal of admission will be processed as per following refund guidelines:

- a) If a candidate withdraws the offer of admission before the commencement of the last round (15/07/2026) of admission, the entire fee collected from the candidate will be refunded after a deduction of processing fee of Rs. 5000/-.
- b) If a candidate withdraws the offer of admission after the last round, the candidate will be refunded only the caution money and advance hostel mess fee.

9.0 OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS

- (a) In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or incomplete or non-eligibility being detected at any time before or after admission, his/her candidature is liable for rejection without further communication.
- (b) An applicant once admitted in a particular postgraduate program will not be allowed to shift to any other program, even if seats remain available in other courses. However, if an adequate number of students is not available in a particular program, IIT(ISM) may not run that Program. In such case, a candidate who has taken admission in that Program may be allowed to change his/her admission to other program (even if the candidate has not applied for that program), where vacant seat is available in the respective categories and matches the qualifications of the candidate with the eligibility condition of that program.
- (c) Students are required to observe prescribed Rules & Regulations and orders issued by the IIT(ISM) authorities from time to time.
